Re: **PENNSYLVANIA CONSTRUCTION CLASSIFICATION PREMIUM ADJUSTMENT
PROGRAM PROVISIONS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2002**
REMINDER

Bureau Circular No. 1418, dated March 14, 2001, announced approved revisions to the Pennsylvania Construction Classification Premium Adjustment Program (PCCPAP) with some provisions effective July 1, 2001 and additional provisions **effective as of 12:01 a.m., January 1, 2002** with respect to new and renewal business only.

This circular will serve as a reminder that the effective date of those additional provisions is approaching.

This new procedure will revise the manner in which the PCCPAP adjusts for the potential redundancy of wage credits between the Experience Rating Plan and the PCCPAP by reducing the amount of the PCCPAP credit rather than increasing the applicable experience modification.

The Bureau will continue to advise qualifying employers and their insurers of record of credits using normal procedures.
