## **BUREAU CIRCULAR NO. 1582**

To All Members of the Bureau:

Re: APPROVAL OF F-CLASSIFICATION AND USL&HW RATING VALUES
BUREAU FILING NO. C-359
EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2011

The PCRB previously filed proposed changes to manual rates and related rating values for Pennsylvania F-Classifications. That filing, Bureau Filing No. C-359, was announced in Bureau Circular No. 1578.

The Pennsylvania Insurance Department has approved Bureau Filing No. C-359 as submitted **effective April 1**, **2011** on a new and renewal basis. The overall rate increase proposed and approved is 6.96 percent.

A table of rates approved effective April 1, 2011 is included with this circular.

Also approved effective April 1, 2011 are the following miscellaneous rating values:

United States Longshore & Harbor Workers' Compensation coverage percentage: 78.13%

Tax multiplier for coverage developed on classifications providing U.S.L. benefits: 1.2736

Expense constant: \$270 (unchanged)
