On behalf of the members of the Pennsylvania Compensation Rating Bureau (PCRB), we hereby submit Filing C-376, which contains revised workers compensation loss costs only for Code 994, Volunteer Firemen, proposed to be **effective 12:01 a.m., February 1, 2019** with respect to new and renewal policies having effective dates on or after that date. No other classification code rating values are changed in this filing.

Subsequent to the January 1, 2019 effective date for approved Filing C-373 (the Protz Adjustment Filing), the Schedule of Annual Loss Costs by population band for Code 994, in Exhibit 5 of that filing, was identified as having incorrect loss cost values. A revised Schedule of Annual Loss Costs for Code 994 is included in this filing.
